2013 LSTA MINI-GRANTS



The mini-grant category funds projects of \$5,000 or less. A maximum of \$50,000 is earmarked for these programs. The State Council on Libraries and Literacy endorses the ranked list of applications and the funds are granted at the direction of the State Library and Archives Administrator.

Mini-grants applications are reviewed by State Library and Archives staff and the State Library and Archives Administrator. As with full grant applications, the projects must be sound, must have a reasonable budget, must have a good evaluation component and the library must be able to accomplish the program in the time allotted.

Below is the ranked order of the mini-grants received for the 2013 funding year. Funding of grants is contingent on the federal monies being allocated to the state.
