
From Feds to Nevada

- ▶ IMLS
 - Institute of Museum and Library Services
 - State Programs
- ▶ Nevada State Library and Archives
- ▶ State Council on Libraries and Literacy
 - Constituted in NRS 380A
 - Conflict of Interest

State Plan 2013 - 2017

- ▶ LSTA Five Year Plan for Nevada
 - ▶ Goals for NV libraries
 - #1 - Strengthen NV libraries' ability to effectively respond to community needs through assessment, planning and training.
 - #2 - Encourage Nevada libraries to develop and use partnerships and collaboration to maximize user resources and services throughout the state.

State Plan 2013 – 2017

- #3 – Nevada libraries will provide responsive learning environments for the state.
 - #4 – Build capacity of libraries to meet user identified access needs.
- 

LSTA Eligibility

- ▶ Supported by public revenues or is a non-profit institution;
 - ▶ Collection organized according to a nationally accepted classification system;
 - ▶ Participates in resource sharing – Information Nevada program;
 - ▶ Serves its primary clientele free of charge;
 - ▶ Has a fixed location with regular, published hours of operation;
 - ▶ Has one or more paid library staff;
 - ▶ Has an annual budget with funds reserved for library materials and services;
 - ▶ Has a current, written long range or strategic plan that is available for review.

- ▶ November 13, 2015 Applications due – NSLA
- ▶ January 26–27, 2016 State Council meeting
- ▶ March 2016 Federal budget??
- ▶ April 2016 ? Award Notification





- ▶ Grant Project manager input



 - ▶ Project Intent
 - ▶ Primary Audience
 - ▶ Partnerships
 - ▶ Project Need
 - Target Population
 - Need
 - Evidence of Need
 - Connection to planning documents

- ▶ Project Activities & Description
 - Activity Information
 - Project Description
 - ▶ Evaluation
 - Project Outputs
 - Project Outcome
 - ▶ Budget Category
 - ▶ Timeline
- 

Get Ready

- ▶ Review Nevada's LSTA State Plan goals
 - ▶ Revisit the library's strategic plan
 - ▶ Determine the community (not library) need
 - ▶ Determine the target group
 - ▶ Identify the benefit to the target group

Framing the Need


- ▶ Section establishes the foundation for the project
 - Based on the users/ patrons
 - Involve the users
 - Establishes the library as the lead
 - Explains “Why now?”
 - Supported by evidence
 - Hard data
 - Soft data



Questions

- ▶ **Who** are the people with the need?
 - ▶ **What** need / problem / opportunity do they have?
 - ▶ **Why** does the problem happen?
 - ▶ **Where** are they located?
 - ▶ **When** does this problem occur?
- 

Who? What?

- ▶ Purpose of LSTA
 - Help libraries meet the needs of their users
 - ▶ Who is /will be most affected?
 - Target population
 - ▶ Identify the problem
 - Involve the target group – ask them
 - ▶ Develop a program to address it
 - ▶ Remember – it's not based on the need of the organization
- 

If the Need is a 'Thing'...


- ▶ Re-evaluate!!
 - ▶ Weak: The 'Large County Library' needs a bookmobile.
 - ▶ Better: Residents of outlying areas of the 'Large County Library' need:
 - Job information
 - Health care information
 - Homework support
- 

Program based projects!

- ▶ Have a significant program component to justify equipment purchase
 - Old equipment is not a justification
 - Not having item is not a justification
- ▶ Supports measurable impact of the project
- ▶ Improvement of services?
 - Based on user-need!

Target Population

- ▶ Who is most affected by the problem?
- ▶ Target is rarely the whole community
- ▶ Be realistic about how many may participate
- ▶ Number expected to be served
 - On 1st page of application




Questions to Consider

- ▶ How does the need relate to:
 - NV LSTA State Plan
 - The Library's mission and strategic plan
 - Other plans
- ▶ Who else is interested?
- ▶ Possible to make a difference with this project?
 - One year

Planning Documents

- ▶ Cite the LSTA goal – NV State Plan
 - Make sure the project is aligned with the goal
 - Identify a primary goal

- ▶ In your local library plan?
 - Identify the planning document
 - Identify the goal or objective
 - **New!** Include link to library plan



Collection Development

- ▶ Program/Subject based
- ▶ Include in the application:
 - How the collection project is connected to improving service(s) to users
 - Review of collection analysis (age, size, strengths, weaknesses)
 - Types of resources that will be purchased
- ▶ Collection development plan*

Other Plans

- ▶ School library?
 - Refer to Information Literacy Standards
 - Common Core or other Curricular standards
 - School Plan – library & instructional role

- ▶ Digital project?
 - Reference the Statewide Digital Plan


