This rich collection of consumer health information provides access to many important consumer health magazines. Full-text content covers topics such as cancer, diabetes, drugs and alcohol and more.



Consumer Health Complete™ (includes AHFS Consumer Medical Information)

The Education Resource Information Center (ERIC) provides access to educational literature and resources. This database provides access to information from journals included in the *Current Index of Journals in Education* and *Resources in Education Index*.



Library, Information Science & Technology Abstracts™ (LISTA)

LISTA indexes a plethora of core, priority and selective journals; plus books, research reports and proceedings. Coverage in the database extends back as far as the mid-1960s.

Teacher Reference Center™

Available via EBSCOhost at no charge, *Teacher Reference Center* covers a variety of topics of interest to teachers, including best practices, curriculum development and school administration.



Primary Search® (includes Funk & Wagnalls New World Encyclopedia)

This comprehensive database provides elementary school students with easy-to-read encyclopedic entries, as well as complete articles from popular magazine titles such as *Boys' Life*, *Highlights*, *Junior Scholastic*, and dozens more.
